From Central America to Brazil, and in the Caribbean islands	Up to 20 meters tall and with a trunk diameter of 50 cm	Grows in Gallery Forests, Rocky Hills and Savannah
Imparipinnate, helicoidal, alternate, oblong, 10 x 4.5 cm	Externally cracked	Flowers in Dec. and Jan., seeds in April and May
Between 0.35 and 0.45	Dark Green, lustrous	By seeds
